

Health and Human Services Commission Contracts

December 6, 2017

Members of the Legislative Audit Committee:

Texas Government Code, Section 321.013(k), requires that, in devising its audit plan, the State Auditor's Office shall consider performing audits of Health and Human Services Commission (Commission) contracts that exceed \$100 million in annual value, including contracts between the Commission and managed care organizations. Pursuant to that requirement, the State Auditor's Office compiled a list of each Commission contract with a total value exceeding \$100 million, as well as all contracts for managed care services.

Based on unaudited information from the Commission's Health and Human Services Contract Administration and Tracking System (HCATS), the State Auditor's Office identified 79 contracts with a total value exceeding \$100 million. Those contracts included:

- Nine contracts related to various aspects of operating Medicaid, Children's Health Insurance, Medical Transportation, and administrative programs.
- Three contracts related to information technology and telecommunications services.
- One contract related to pharmacy providers for the Vendor Drug Program.
- Forty-nine contracts for managed care services.
- One interlocal contract related to mental health services.
- Sixteen long-term care contracts transitioned from the Department of Aging and Disability Services to the Commission during fiscal year 2017.

Objective, Scope, and Methodology

The objective of this project was to identify and analyze Commission contracts exceeding \$100 million in total value, including those with managed care organizations.

The project scope included active Commission contracts exceeding \$100 million in total value and all contracts for managed care services as of June 1, 2017.

This project was not an audit. The project relied on self-reported Commission information regarding contracts and their associated expenditures. That information was not subject to the tests and confirmations that would be performed in an audit. However, the information in this report was subject to certain quality control procedures to help ensure accuracy. The following members of the State Auditor's Office staff performed the project:

According to the Commission, as of June 1, 2017, expenditures for those 79 contracts had totaled approximately \$93.3 billion. For the purposes of this project, HCATS was the most complete repository of Commission contract data, including data on expenditures associated with those contracts. Additionally, the State Auditor's Office reviewed expenditure data from the Commission's financial system (the Health

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and Human Services Administrative System) to determine the reasonableness of total expenditures for certain contracts.

The State Auditor's Office will include the information identified in this report in its risk assessment process for selecting contracts to audit during fiscal year 2018. A list of the 79 contracts discussed above is attached to this letter.

Summary of Health and Human Services Commission Contracts

Table 1 lists each Health and Human Services Commission (Commission) contract with a total value exceeding \$100 million, as well as all contracts for managed care services. The Commission reported that unaudited information as of June 1, 2017. It generated that information from its Health and Human Services Contract Administration and Tracking System (HCATS).

For the purposes of this project, HCATS was the most complete repository of Commission contract data, including expenditures associated with those contracts. Additionally, the State Auditor's Office reviewed expenditure data from the Commission's financial system (the Health and Human Services Administrative System) to determine the reasonableness of total expenditures for certain contracts.
