

A Summary of

Regional Planning Commissions' Reports

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Regional planning commissions (RPCs) must provide certain information to the State Auditor's Office each year. All 24 RPCs submitted the required asset disposal, productivity, and performance reports. However, not all RPCs complied with annual financial report and salary schedule reporting requirements.

Audited Annual Financial Reports. For fiscal year 2023, all but one of the 24 regional planning commissions (RPCs) in Texas submitted all statutorily required audited annual financial reports to the State Auditor's Office. That RPC, South Texas Development Council, did

not submit an audited financial report for fiscal year 2023. Instead, it submitted one for fiscal year 2022. All audited annual financial reports submitted contained all the elements required by Texas Local Government Code, Chapter 391. External certified public accountants issued unmodified opinions on those financial statements.

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Salary Schedules. All 24 RPCs submitted their fiscal year 2025 salary schedules to the State Auditor's Office. Some reports were submitted late or initially contained salaries exceeding the maximums authorized by statute.

Eight RPCs (33.3 percent) submitted their salary schedules after the statutorily required due dates:

- Central Texas Council of Governments (see Chapter 1-E).
- Concho Valley Council of Governments (see Chapter 1-G).
- Golden Crescent Regional Planning Commission (see Chapter 1-J).
- Middle Rio Grande Development Council (see <u>Chapter 1-N</u>).
- North Central Texas Council of Governments (see Chapter 1-P).
- Permian Basin Regional Planning Commission (see <u>Chapter 1-R</u>).
- South Texas Development Council (see <u>Chapter 1-V</u>).
- Texoma Council of Governments (see Chapter 1-W).

Of the 24 RPCs, 3 (12.5 percent) submitted salary schedules with positions whose salaries or salary ranges exceeded those of the state salary schedules:

- Central Texas Council of Governments (see Chapter 1-E).
- Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council (see <u>Chapter 1-M</u>).
- West Central Texas Council of Governments (see Chapter 1-X).

After auditors identified those errors and communicated them to the RPCs, the Central Texas Council of Governments and the Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council submitted revised schedules with salaries or salary ranges that were less than or equal to the maximum salaries authorized by statute. The West Central Texas Council of Governments indicated that it would work to submit a revised salary schedule.

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Background Information

Regional Planning Commissions

Regional planning commissions (RPCs) are governed by Texas Local Government Code, Chapter 391. The 24 RPCs in Texas are political subdivisions created to improve the health, safety, and general welfare of residents and to plan for future development. RPCs can receive funds from state, federal, and other sources to support their purposes. Texas Local Government Code, Section 391.0095(a), requires that each RPC annually submit to the State Auditor:

- The amount and source of funds received.
- The amount and source of funds expended.
- An explanation of any method the RPC used to compute an expense, including computation of any indirect costs.
- A report of the RPC's productivity and performance during the annual reporting period.
- A projection of the RPC's productivity and performance during the next annual reporting period.
- The results of an audit of the RPC's affairs prepared by an independent certified public accountant.
- A report of any assets of which the RPC disposed.

Texas Local Government Code, Sections 391.0117(e) and (f), require each RPC that meets certain conditions to submit to the State Auditor the RPC's salary schedule, including the salaries of all exempt positions, no later than the 45th day before the beginning of the RPC's fiscal year.



After auditors communicated the error to the RPC, it submitted a revised salary schedule that did not exceed the salary range in the state classification salary schedule. In addition, the salary schedule was not submitted in a timely manner, as required. Texas Local Government Code, Section 391.0117(e), requires the schedule to be submitted not later than the 45th day before the beginning of the commission's fiscal year. The RPC's salary schedule was due by May 17, 2024; however, the RPC submitted its salary schedule on September 26, 2024.



However, this RPC did not submit its salary schedule by the statutorily required due date. Texas Local Government Code, Section 391.0117(e), requires an RPC to submit its salary schedule to the State Auditor's Office no later than the 45th day before the beginning of the RPC's fiscal year. The RPC's salary schedule was due by August 17, 2024; however, the RPC submitted its salary schedule on December 20, 2024.

Annual Financial Report. The RPC did not submit its financial statement for fiscal year 2023 to the State Auditor's Office; instead, it provided its financial statement for fiscal year 2022, in which it received an unmodified opinion. This RPC's fiscal year 2022 audited annual financial report contained all the elements required by Texas Local Government Code, Chapter 391. The RPC indicated that the financial statement for fiscal year 2023 would not be completed until the end of February 2025.


